Vicki Siegel (Ciresias) worked on the **AE** production of *Lysistrata* in 2007, a production noted for long balloons. Since then she has had two original musicals produced by **AE** – *A Hot Day in Ephesus* based on A Comedy of Errors and *What Do Women Want* – *the Marriage of Sir Gawain* based on the Canterbury Tales and adapted two main stage shows – *Knight of the Burning Pestle* and *Complete Works of Shakespeare Abridged* adapted for 9 actors. Interestingly, Ciresias was played by Kevin Bacon in its off Broadway incarnation so I guess that gives her one degree of separation.

GiGi A Tasse (old woman 2) after an acting absence by some fluke wound up in a grindhouse film playing a vegan psycho killer. This led to a commercial, more film and musical theatre where she was featured as a 90 year old Italian /ex stripper, alcoholic mom of a tweeker, hoarder slumlord and German lesbian concentration survivor. GiGi wanted to ask her therapist about the significance of these roles, but her therapist no longer takes sliding scale.

Baki Tezcan (Geezer 2 / Spartan Envoy) acted in Turkish in Istanbul and Ankara in the late 1980s and early 1990s. After twenty years in the US, he returned to stage at the Art Theater of Davis with two Chekhov plays. *Lysistrata* is his fourth staged reading with the **Actors Ensemble** this year.

Vicki Victoria (Old Woman 1/Fisherwoman) actually stood on The Acropolis last month on an extended vacation in Greece. With dust from Athens still on her sandals inspiring her, she embarks on her 8th production with AEB. Efcharistó polý!

Lisa Wang (Athenian Chorus Leader 1) is excited to be joining this spirited and talented cast for this raucous sex comedy!
